THE AMENDMENTS TO THE REGULATIONS R-2012 FOR B.E / B.TECH PROGRAMME.

Existing

University Department – B.E./B.Tech. Regulation 2012; Clause 16.2.2

A candidate who satisfies the following conditions shall be declared to have passed the examination in First class:

- Should have passed the End semester examination in all the courses of all eight semesters (six semesters for lateral entry) within four years (three years for lateral entry students).
 Withdrawal from examination (vide Clause 17) will not be construed as an appearance.
- Should have secured a CGPA of not less than 6.50
- One year authorized break of study (if availed of) or prevention from writing End semester examination due to lack of attendance is permitting in addition to four years for the award of First class.

To be changed as

University Department – B.E./B.Tech. Regulation 2012;Clause 16.2.2

A candidate who satisfies the following conditions shall be declared to have passed the examination in First class:

- Should have passed the End semester examination in all the courses of all eight semesters (six semesters for lateral entry) within five years (four years for lateral entry students), which includes one year of authorized break of study (if availed) or prevention from writing the End Semester examination due to lack of attendance (if applicable). Withdrawal from examination (vide Clause 17) will not be construed as an appearance.
- Should have secured a CGPA of not less than 6.50

Existing

University Department – B.E./B.Tech. Regulation 2012; Clause 10.1

Internal Assessment for Theory courses:

 The maximum marks for Internal Assessment shall be 50 in case of theory courses.

Three assessments, carrying 100 marks each shall be conducted by the Department. At least two out of these three, shall be written tests. If any one of the assessments is not a written test, then, the details of specified mode of assessment proposed shall be finalized in the class committee and informed to the students well in advance. The total marks obtained in all the three assessments should be given equal weightage of 16.66 each and reduced to 50 marks and rounded to the nearest integer.

University Department – B.E./B.Tech. Regulation 2012; Clause 10.1

Internal Assessment for Theory courses:

- The maximum marks for Internal Assessment shall be 50 marks in case of theory courses.
- Three assessments each carrying 100 marks shall be conducted by the Department. The Total marks obtained in the best 2 assessments out of 3 put together should be reduced to 50 marks and rounded to the nearest integer.
